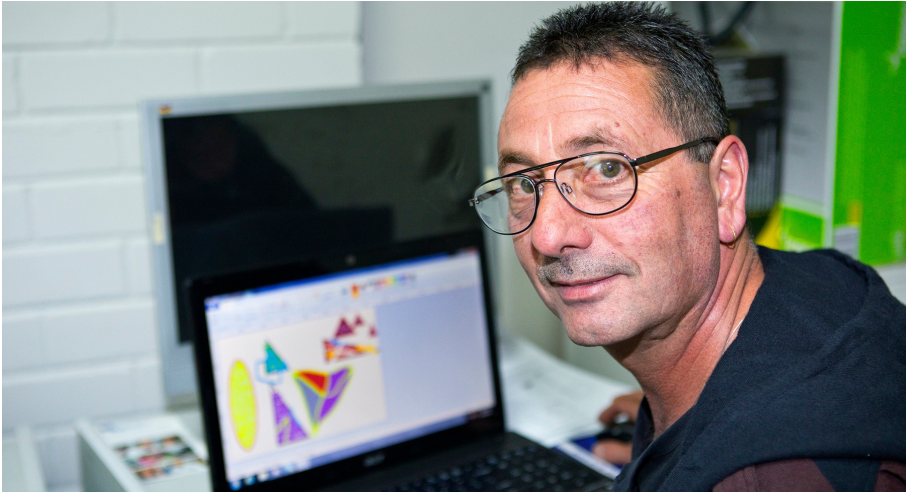

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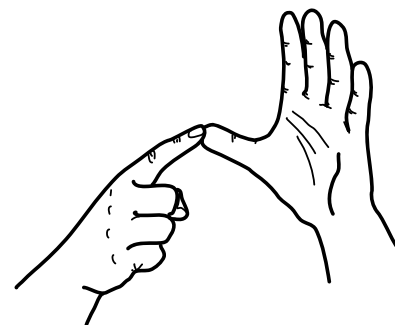

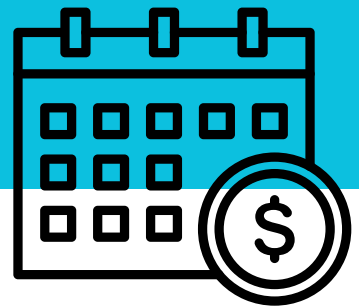

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YOUR TERM FEES



Traralgon Neighbourhood Learning House is a not-for-profit community-based organisation and as such we endeavour to keep our class fees manageable and available to all. Please note we have increased our pricing slightly this term.

When you register to attend a course, you do so for the term.

Term fees are expected to be paid in full in the first week of term to secure your place. Payment can be made at 11-13 Breed Street Traralgon by EFTPOS (preferred) or cash. We can also take credit card payments over the phone.

When you pay upfront, you pay your fees at a reduced rate.

Those who choose to pay & attend casually pay a slightly higher weekly fee.

All classes you enrol in for a term are expected to be paid for, whether you attend or not. Tutors, room hire and other costs still need to be paid and courses are scheduled based on student enrolments.

One off Workshop fees are to be paid in full prior to the day of the workshop. Your enrolment is not guaranteed until payment has been received.

Our courses/workshops are very popular and sometimes full. Please ensure you confirm your enrolment.

We have two computers for public use during office hours.



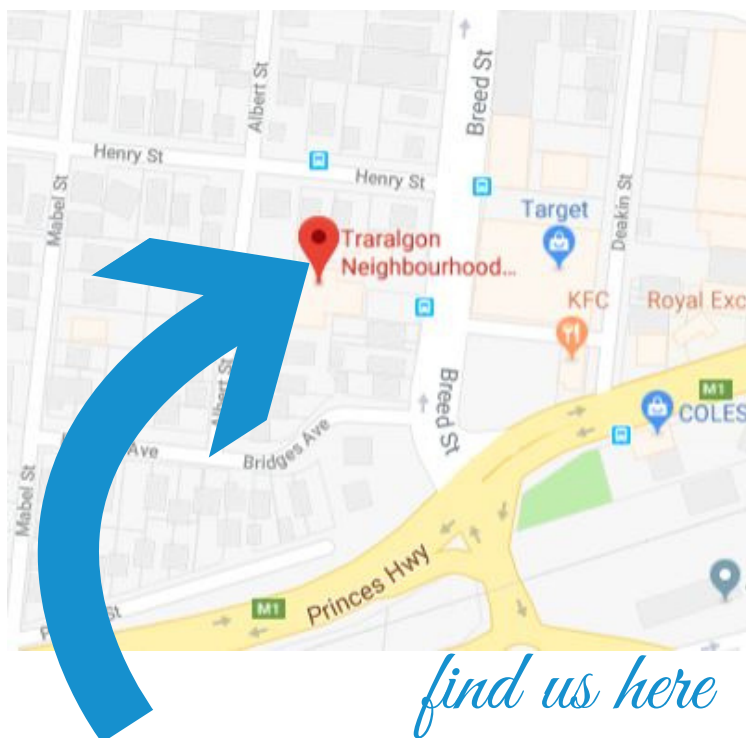
